<sup>1</sup> An Evolutionarily Significant Unit, or “ESU”, is a distinctive group of Pacific salmon or steelhead. NOAA Fisheries considers an ESU a “species” under the Endangered Species Act.

<sup>2</sup> In September of 2001, the U.S. District Court in Eugene, Oregon, in [Alsea Valley Alliance v. Evans](#) (161 F. Supp. 2d 1154, D. Ore. 2001), set aside the 1998 ESA listing of Oregon Coast coho salmon (63 FR 42587; 08/10/1998), and remanded the case to NOAA for re-consideration consistent with the Court’s ruling.
