 SUBJECT: PRELIMINARY Report 11 -- 2008 Pacific Whiting Fishery

This report consolidates preliminary state, federal, and tribal data for the 2008 Pacific whiting fishery. Due to concerns about the incidental catch of overfished species, bycatch limits are in place in the non-tribal sectors of the fishery. On October 12, the non-tribal sectors were reopened and the bycatch limits were revised. The current bycatch limits are: 6.4 mt for canary rockfish (increasing to 6.7 mt on October 26), 40 mt for darkblotched rockfish, and 287 mt for widow rockfish. When a bycatch limit is reached, the primary whiting seasons for the non-tribal fisheries are ended regardless of the amount of whiting allocation remaining.
